| Purpose | The OPWA Public Works Project of the Year Award was established to promote excellence in the management and administration of public works projects by recognizing the alliance between the managing agency, the consultant/architect/engineer, and the contractor who, working together complete public works projects |
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| Eligibility | Projects can be submitted by any managing agency that is a member of OPWA. The project value must fit into one of the following categories: 1) Projects less than \$2 million 2) Projects of \$2 million to \$10 million, 3) Projects of \$10 million and up |
| Nomination Process | Nominations of Project of the Year Awards should be made by the managing public agency or OPWA chapter or branches. |

| Selection | Submissions will be reviewed and scored by the Awards Committee members and winning projects will be selected for each category and project value ranges. |
| Deadline | February 23, 2024 |
| Presentation | For the winning submissions, designated representatives from the public agency, contractor and consultant (one each) will be given a framed certificate following the annual National Public Works Week Event. |
