

Public Works Project of the Year for Small Municipalities Award

Criteria Form

Category includes Structures, transportation, environmental, historical restoration/preservation, disaster or emergency construction

Purpose This OPWA Public Works Project of the Year Award was established to promote excellence in the management and administration of public works projects by recognizing projects completed by small municipalities. It also recognizes the alliance between the managing agency, the consultant/architect/engineer, and the contractor who, working together complete public works projects

Eligibility Any municipality with a population of less than 50,000 people can submit a project in this category. There is no dollar value for the projects, the municipality must demonstrate the impact the project had on their community.

Nomination Process Nominations of Individual Awards should be made by the managing public agency or OPWA chapter or branches.

Selection Submissions will be reviewed and scored by the Awards Committee members and winning projects will be selected for each category.

Deadline March 6th, 2026 to be eligible.

Presentation For the winning submissions, designated representatives from the public agency, contractor and consultant (one each) will be given a framed certificate following the annual National Public Works Week Event.
